As a volunteer boat captain, I agree to:

- Be 18 or older and remain in the boat with two student anglers at all times during competition. Three people aboard, always. Fishing alone is never permitted.
- Require every person aboard to wear a fastened USCG-approved chest-type PFD whenever the combustion engine is running and in gear, from boat check to weigh-in.
- Keep the emergency kill switch attached to me whenever the combustion engine is running. Students do not drive under combustion power.
- Never fish, cast, or hold a rod during tournament hours. I may net, measure, cull, and coach.
- Not purchase fishing information, hire guides, place brush or attractors, use drones, or share tournament-water information through closed groups within 10 days of an event.
- Attend the pre-tournament meeting and check in with both anglers. Arrive at check-in on time.
- Monitor weather and bring the boat in when conditions become unsafe, regardless of tournament standing. Safety outranks points.
- Keep a working livewell and aerator, and release all fish healthy after weigh-in.
- Follow all federal, state, and local boating laws and carry required safety equipment (fire extinguisher, throwable, horn, lights).
- Model sportsmanship. No alcohol or drugs at any tournament-related activity.

Reimbursement

Captains may be reimbursed for actual fuel and travel expenses only, per OKHSF rules. Captains are never paid for their time or fishing knowledge. Submit the Fuel Reimbursement Form with receipts after each event.
