



Tournament Day Checklist

Owasso Fishing Team · Print it. Tape it to the tackle box.

The night before

- Registration confirmed (deadline was Thursday 11:59 PM — \$20 late fee after)
- Pre-tournament meeting attended or approved absence
- Off the water by 6:00 PM
- Rods rigged, batteries charged, livewell tested
- Alarm set. Check-in is before dawn.

Angler

- SAF & OKHSF membership confirmation
- Signed entry/release form + proof of enrollment
- Fishing license (16 and older)
- PFD (chest-type, USCG-approved)
- Rods, tackle, culling clips, weigh-in bag
- Team jersey for weigh-in
- Rain gear, layers, sunscreen, polarized glasses
- Water, snacks, lunch
- Phone charged — for emergencies

Boat captain

- Boat 16 ft+ with working livewell and aerator
- Kill switch lanyard attached to you
- PFDs for all three aboard
- Fire extinguisher, throwable, horn, lights
- Boat registration + your license
- Full fuel tank
- Key fob picked up at check-in — return it at weigh-in or forfeit points

On the water

- 5 bass limit, 12-inch minimum (or lake rule). Cull immediately on the sixth fish.
- Largemouth, smallmouth, spotted, redeye only
- Late to check-in = 1 lb per minute. 15+ minutes = zero.
- Dead fish = 8 oz penalty each. Keep the aerator running.
